3. Accreditation

The accreditation centre is located at the Regatta House.

All participants of the competition must be accredited. Without accreditation the access to the venue is not possible. Please note that you will not be accredited until you have a zero balance with the Organising Committee.

Payment can only be realised in cash (Euros).

Please bring the original passports or ID cards (for European citizens only) to the Accreditation staff. Passports should be in alphabetical order and photocopies provided (these should be left with the staff).

The team leader will get all the accreditations, personal numbers and the welcome bag with all the necessary information.

Before leaving the Accreditation Centre, team leaders will be asked to control the national flag and the national anthem. Additionally, we will need their mobile phone number so they can be reached a in case of an urgent matter. Furthermore they are pleased to indicate 1 team member to present the flag during the opening ceremony.

ITO meeting

The ITO meeting will be held directly after the team leader's meeting in room 11 on the first floor at the Regatta House.

Opening ceremony

Date: Tuesday, August 22 - 19:00 Klönnewiese (direction stadium)

The representatives (1 per team) will line up in alphabetical order by Nation. More information at your arrival at the accreditation centre.

The opening ceremony will last about 2 hours. Transportation will be provided by the shuttle bus lines and additional busses for all the hotels.

PaddleAll

The races will take place on Thursday, August 24, 12:40 - 13:15.

Medal ceremonies will be realised at 13:30.

Athletes participating at the II demonstration races do not need to go through the parallel channel. They are allowed to go to the start area at the regatta course outside the lanes.

VIP Lounge

The VIP area operating during competition is located on the first floor in the Regatta House. You can access the area behind the building.

Medal ceremony

Medal ceremonies will be held following the finals as per the race program.

The top three athletes/crews should come to the area at the finish tower **15 minutes before their ceremony.** Team leader of the winning athlete/crew will be part of the medal ceremony.

To maintain the formality of the ceremony the athletes receiving medals **MUST wear their national team uniform and proper footwear.**

No Flags, caps or sunglasses are allowed at the podium.

Medal ceremonies will start at their officially scheduled time. In case any athlete arrives late to the meeting point, ceremony will start without him/her.

On Sunday, the medal ceremonies for the 5000m races will be held once all four races are finished. The change area for the athletes will be located next to the finish tower. Team Leaders or coaches are required to bring the national team uniform and shoes to this area. Athletes should remain in this area until they are ready to be accompanied to the podium, together with the team leader of the winning nation.

Closing ceremony

The closing ceremony will take place after the last medal ceremony in front of the Grandstand.

We would love to celebrate the closing of this unforgettable event together with all the teams.

Boat and personal numbers

The personal numbers to be worn during the whole duration of the competition will be collected by the Team leader during the accreditation process. The boat numbers can be collected immediately before the race at the designated place at the boat storage area. All boat numbers must be returned directly after the race at the same place.

If there is a personal number missing, you can go to the competition office at the Regatta House.

Boat control

Teams can find a self boat control in the athletes area in a separated tent between the outside boat storage and the building with the changing rooms.

After the race boats will be directly called to the post-race boat control next to the finish line on the finish tower's side.

Boat stickers

The athlete's name sticker must be applied on all boats for ICF Canoe Sprint and Paracanoe competitions. In order for the canoes and kayaks to be presented in a standard manner, the name stickers must be positioned at the same point on every boat. The country code sticker will be applied on all boats and at the same place for each ICF Canoe Sprint competition. The stickers will be checked at the Boat Control. It is the participating national federations' responsibility to provide the stickers to their athletes. **There will be no possibility to print those at the venue.**

Athlete names stickers have been modified to match the re-formatted TV graphics. The last name is now placed after the initial first name.

Athletes will not be permitted to race A-Finals without the appropriate boat stickers.

Uniformity

We want to remind you that "In a crew boat there must be uniformity among all athletes including clothing sleeve length, hats, headbands, and spray deck covers." (13.9.2.d)

Media service

Athletes who are required by media for an interview will be called after each race. They need to disembark at the same pontoon that is used for the post-race boat control. Apart from calling their lane numbers aloud, the lane numbers will be displayed, too.

5000m races

The 5000m races will be held on Sunday afternoon.

Competitors race 6 laps and need to pass 5 portages from the second lap.

The start will be realised on the finish line with the starting machine.

The exact race plan you will find in the team leader's bag and on our webpage once it is confirmed by ICF.

Important information for the 5000m race:

- Handles on boats are permitted.
- Pumps are NOT permitted!
- Sprint boats (kayaks 12kg, canoe 14kg) to be used only.
- Any athlete who is considered by a Course Umpire or Chief Official to have been responsible for a collision, or who damages the boat or paddle of another athlete or unnecessarily deviates from the direct racing line or deliberately blocks or impedes the path of an athlete may be penalised or disqualified. (10.5.4.c)
- Lapped boats are supposed to leave the race the next time they reach the finish line but they will keep their ranking. (10.5.5.a/ 10.5.5.c)
- Lapped boats not leaving the race according to above rule will be disqualified, hence losing their ranking. (10.5.5.d)
- No disqualification of the last athlete at the end of laps!

Anti-Doping

The selected competitors are subject to doping control conforming to the relevant regulations at the designated place. Athletes need to have their ID card available.

If selected for doping control, the athlete must comply with the obligations stipulated in the ICF and WADA doping rules.

6. Meals

Breakfast will be served in all hotels.

Lunch and dinner will be served in a big Catering tent behind the Grandstand on the triangle lawn. The entry will be controlled. With personal accreditation you get access to the catering tent. There is a barcode at the accreditation which needs to be scanned at the entrance.

Teams who booked Airport transfer will be welcomed at the airport and brought to the shuttle. In case of any problems at the airport you can contact the Transport service.



Shuttle service between official hotels and venue

For transportation between the official hotels and the venue we have installed three shuttle bus lines. You can find the different routes in the team leader's bag and we publish them online. You can recognise our busses by the official signs. At the hotels you will get detailed information about exact location of the shuttle stop.

Please be aware that during the afternoon hours we expect a high volume of traffic, so it would be useful to take a bus earlier.

For teams in the hotels: B&B-Nord, B&B-Süd and Intercity due to traffic restrictions it is necessary to walk about 5 minutes to the "Fernbusbahnhof" (Mercatorstraße 44 - on the right side of the Intercity).



Departure Information

Team leaders are asked to hand over the departure information at the Accreditation centre. Last minute changes needs to be directed directly to the Transport service team.
